International Women's Day 2024: WIEN Calls for Inclusion and Diversity in Line with SDGs



Women in Energy Network have called on the government and private sector organizations to intensify actions on the issue of gender equality in the country, saying that the on-going search for solution to multifaceted economic challenges of the country may end up as a barren exercise without resolving the issue of inclusivity and diversity.

WIEN emphasized that - in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) - government should adopt and strengthen sound policies and enforceable legislation for the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls at all levels. This, they insisted, would instigate and compel private sector groups in the country to begin to take diversity and inclusion seriously and integrate same as part of their corporate policies.

They regretted that despite their significant contributions to socioeconomic and political development in the country, as facts and figures have demonstrated, women's representation is not keeping pace with their efforts, a situation which they said does not harmonize with what obtains in other climes and the declarations of the global bodies like the United Nations, World Bank and International Monetary Fund.

WIEN's brilliant and highly-articulate women who spoke on Friday 15th March, in Lagos, where they gathered on an IWD 2024 Round Table discussion at Pier Harbour, Victoria Island, to deliberate on the theme: Breaking Barriers, Building Inclusive Teams and Fostering Diversity in the Workplace, noted that everyone is equal in dignity and deserves to be treated equally and wondered why it should be different in Nigeria.

The event which was organized by the American Business Council (ABC) in collaboration with Women In Energy Network (WIEN) and sponsors: Pier Harbour , GE Health Care and Google, aligns with the campaign theme for International Women's Day (IWD) 2024 which is 'Inspire Inclusion.
